

Registering: What you need to bring

Welcome to the civic voter registration drive for PNC Elections.

Below are the documents you need to bring with you to the registration center.

Everybody must bring an official ID card:

Documents needed	Some examples
An official identification document with the registrant's name, photograph and date of birth.	Passport, official identification card, official refugee documentation, driver's license.

AND also bring a document showing you are Palestinian

Documents needed	Some examples
An official document, valid or expired, that was issued to a Palestinian OR that shows that the registrant was born in Palestine. The document must: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Carry the applicant's name, and,ii. State explicitly that it was issued to a Palestinian, or,iii. list his/her place of birth in Palestine.	Passport, birth certificate, official identification card, driver's license, official host country or refugee documentation.

OR:

A document showing that your parent/ancestor is Palestinian or was born in Palestine.

Documents needed	Some examples
Palestinians who do not hold a document showing their Palestinian identity can register using: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. a document showing the Palestinian nationality of their ancestor, andii. a document linking them to the ancestor, if the document used does not clearly show the relationship by name.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Birth certificate of an ancestor, UNRWA registration card of the family, other document showing origin/birth in Palestineii. Passport indicating mother's name, a parent's document showing link with ancestor

For Palestinians who do not have any of the above documents that identify them as Palestinian:

Social vouching

Palestinians who do not hold any of the documents listed above can still register. They must bring a Palestinian witness to the voter registration centre, and answer some questions according the vouching identification system, which is commonly used in out-of-country and refugee voting.

For spouses of Palestinians:

Documents Needed	Some Examples
Persons who are married to a Palestinian can be registered using: i. A marriage certificate, and, ii. Proof of the Palestinian identity of the spouse	Marriage certificate, and documents listed
